Hong Wen ESL Program is gearing up for an exciting and vibrant future! Our mission is to ensure our students develop the English language skills needed for academic, professional, and social purposes by offering a variety of programs to cater for individual needs.

Our instruction and curriculum has gone through a detailed revamp. Our curriculum will spiral while focusing on meaningful context and categorized into three phases: ESL I (Elementary/Beginner), ESL II (Intermediate), and ESL III (Advanced).

These phases are based on a child's English proficiency. Children begin their second language acquisition at Hong Wen ESL Program starting somewhere in these phases. The outcome of this instructional process must enable children to listen, comprehend, speak, read, write, analyze and think in English.

Our goals are clear. By the end of Grade 9, dependent on your starting English level, our objective is for students to pass GEPT Basic or Intermediate. But we will go beyond just the local assessment and provide the opportunity for students to take the international assessments such as the TOEIC and Cambridge offerings.

Hong Wen ESL Program uses only English as the instructional language and fully trained instructors to achieve English proficiency and academic mastery of subject matter content and higher order skills, including critical thinking.

Facing a digital and fast-changing world, the pedagogies in Hong Wen Senior High School are always ahead of other schools. We use the most advanced TV broadcast system to enhance our students' listening skills. Our teachers simply upload the latest listening materials giving our students immediately access to this resource. Referring to the ability of speaking, besides practicing in class, the students are also tasked to participate in the group activities which encourages speech and role play, providing real life situations to best reflect use of language.
